

68% of all new, full-time and part-time, degree or certificate-seeking, college-level students who began in fall 2022 received an award in fall 2022 or were enrolled in spring 2023. Students in the cohort include first-time students to college after graduating from high school, some of whom were enrolled at WNC as high school students, and students transferring in credits from elsewhere. The data below disaggregate persistence rates by demographic and enrollment variables and report the most recent cohort size and persistence rate, the trends for entering students from fall 2018 to fall 2022, and a comparison to the most recent overall persistence rate (yellow line at 68%) for all new students in fall 2022.
